Re: Town Sporting Event Concession Stands

All concession stands must be licensed with the R.I. Department of Health. There is no charge for non-profit organizations for this license.

If a concession stand is operating without a certified manager they are limited to the following food items: Hot dogs, cheese or plain pizza, pre-cooked hamburgers and cheeseburgers, pre-packaged foods and drinks. Coffee may be served with an approved well or city water.

If they have a certified manager and approved facilities ie: required sinks, equipment and utensils and an approved well they are not limited in what they can prepare and serve.

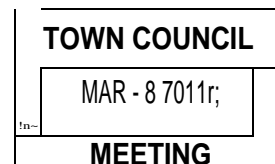
